PUBLIC INFORMATION STATEMENT

Over the course of the past two weeks, the City of Jackson has placed two ambulance service employees on administrative leave amid ongoing employee investigations. One of the employees has since resigned from their employment with the City of Jackson.

The City has been informed by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office that an arrest of one of the employees related to this matter has occurred. Questions related to the criminal investigation need to be directed to the Jackson County Sheriff's Office.

The City of Jackson retained an independent, neutral investigator in November of 2025 to investigate the Jackson Ambulance Service operations. This ongoing investigation will include the most recent employee complaints.

The Jackson City Council is committed to factual, timely, and transparent communication regarding all aspects of our municipal operations to our residents. Minnesota data privacy laws prohibit the dissemination of any additional information regarding this matter at this time. It is vitally important to note that the Jackson Ambulance Service will continue to provide high-quality emergency medical services to the community without being affected by the ongoing employee investigations.
