

## **Jackson County Sheriff's Office Report August 17<sup>th</sup> to August 23<sup>rd</sup>**

### **8-17 Monday**

9:31 AM A deputy responded to a child welfare concern.

1:41 PM A deputy responded to a report of someone receiving threats on a social media app.

8:53 PM Deputies responded to a report of a careless driver in Alpha.

### **8-18 Tuesday**

1:39 AM Dispatch transferred a 911 call to the MN State Patrol of a driving complaint on I-90 near Lakefield. The caller stated a vehicle was only travelling about 35 mph, nearly hit a mile marker pole, and had both tires into the median at one point.
