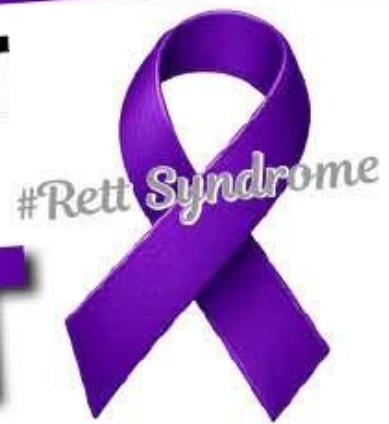

Mason's Story

Mason Behrens, age 4, became seriously ill in February 2025 and was soon diagnosed with Rett syndrome at just 17 months old.

Rett syndrome is a complex genetic disorder that typically appears between 6 and 18 months of age. It is most commonly diagnosed in girls and is extremely rare in boys. Symptoms can include the loss of motor skills, communication abilities, and hand function, along with a compromised immune system. Mason is one of fewer than 100 boys ever diagnosed with Rett syndrome.

Since his diagnosis, Mason and his family have faced countless hospital stays, medical procedures, and appointments at Gillette Children's Hospital in St. Paul, Minnesota. In 2025 alone, Mason spent a total of 167 days in the hospital. While 2026 has brought progress and more time at home, the family continues to make frequent trips to St. Paul for treatments and extended medical care.

Mason lives in Windom with his parents, Jesse and Lisa Behrens, and his big sister, Haley, age 6. Your support will help ease the financial burden of ongoing medical expenses and remind the Behrens family that they are surrounded by a caring and supportive community that stands with them as they move forward in their next step in the fight.
